

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

---



Does a board member need to be sworn in at a board meeting, or can we administer the oath of office at any time?

*It is acceptable if a board member is not able to attend the organizational meeting, but the board member needs to be sworn in. Arrangements can be made with the individual.*

If no appointment is made by November X (election day), does the vacancy turn into a 2-year term appointment or remain as a 4-year appointment?

*Remains as its original 4-year term.*

Is it acceptable to have board applicant that is a Business Manager at another Consortium district, and would there be any conflicts for this board member with Consortium issues?

*Yes, it is acceptable to have a business manager from another Consortium district as a board member. The member would have to abstain from any issues pertaining to the Consortium.*

If a current board member's term expires in December, does the board member have to participate in the December Organizational meeting?

*No, the board member does not participate in the Organizational meeting since his/her term ends on the second Friday of December when the new person is seated.*

If a board member is selling their house because they are moving and rents back their current home to transition to a new home (still residing in the district for one additional month) can they continue to serve as a board member and make their resignation effective when they stop renting in the district?

*Yes, if the board member is between the two residences and one exists in the district, they can remain a board member for the extra month of transitioning (and renting).*
